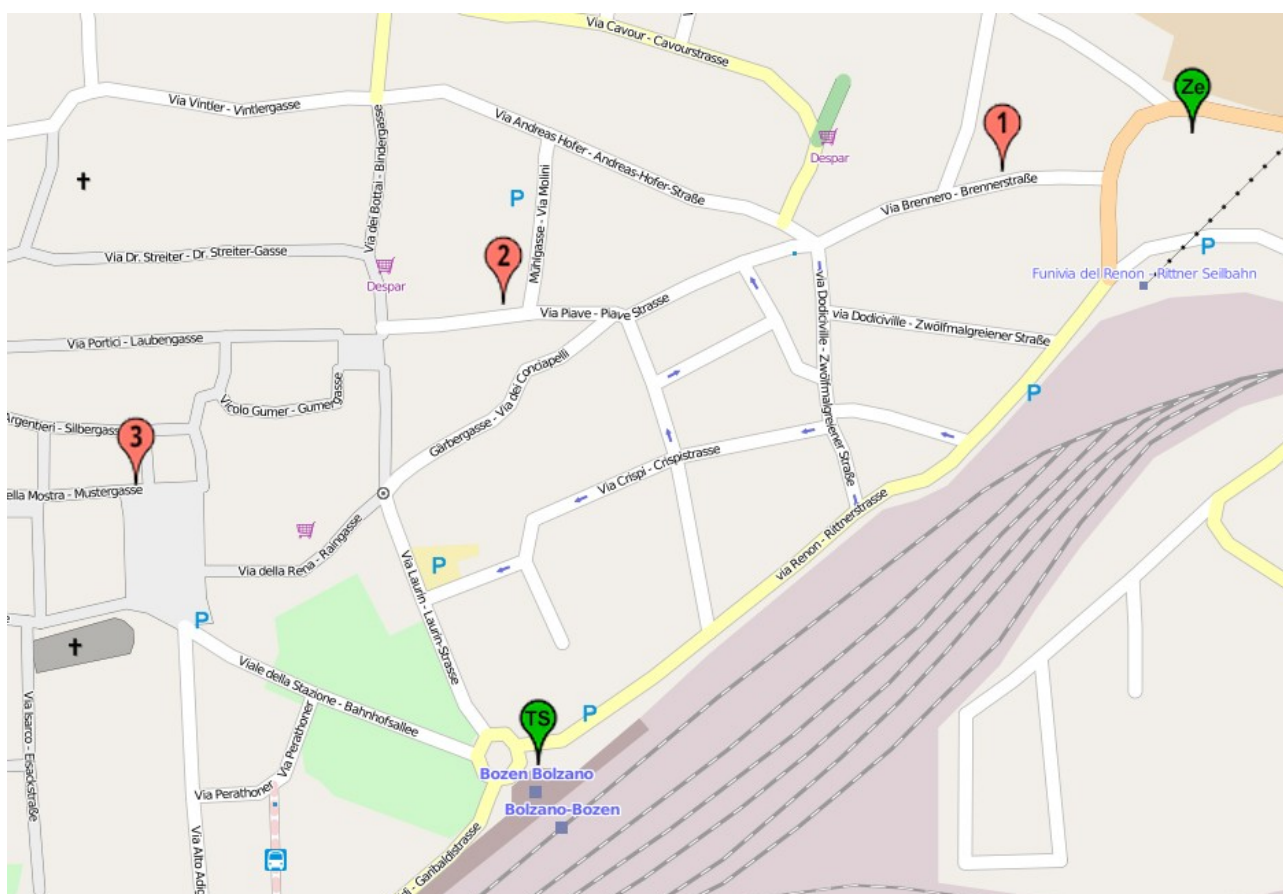

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE DAYS

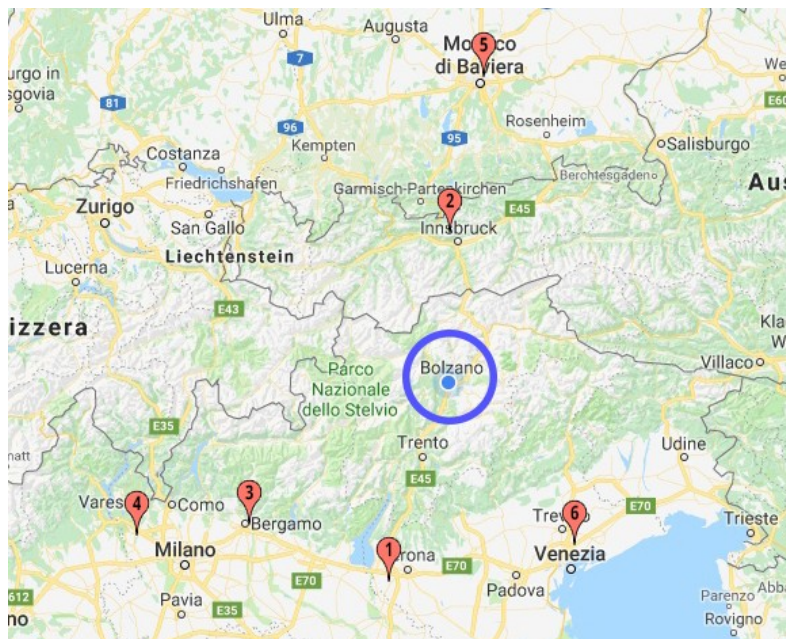
April 26 is “arrival day”, while April 29 is “departure day”.

On arrival day there will a Masterclass from 2.30 onwards. On the departure day we will organise some city tours around architecture, history and our most famous citizen: Ötzi the Iceman!

GETTING TO BOLZANO

Please note: South Tyrol (Alto Adige / Südtirol) is a bilingual autonomous region, with Italian and German speaking populations. All street signs, train stops and public information are at least in two languages (Italian and German). For this reason the directions below use both languages; by the way, “Bolzano” and “Bozen” are exactly the same place. You might need to use both names when searching trains or other public transport.

→ **By PLANE:**



The two nearest airports are (travel times are intended by train to Bolzano/Bozen):

- **1 Verona Catullo - VRN** (Italy) - <http://www.aeroporto.verona.it/> - ca. 2 hours by train or busses.
- **2 Innsbruck - INN** (Austria) - <http://www.innsbruck-airport.com/> - ca. 2 hours by train or busses.

Other airports (travel times are intended by train to Bolzano/Bozen):

- **3 Milano Orio al Serio - BGY** - <http://www.sacbo.it/> - actually located in the province of Bergamo, it's a “tricky” airport: most of low-cost flights arrive here, but it's a bit difficult to reach. You should either go to Milan or Brescia by bus, and then take a train – ca. 4:30 hours by public transports. For this airport we strongly suggest taking the bus (see below).
- **4 Milano Malpensa- MXP** - <http://www.sea-aeroporto.milano.it/> - is one of the biggest international airport in the North of Italy. It's about 1 hour from the Central Train Station of Milan (reachable by bus and train) – ca. 5 hours by public transports. Buses available (see below).
- **5 Munich- MUC** (Germany) - <http://www.munich-airport.de/en/> - Munich is about 4/4:30 hours by train from Bolzano/Bozen. Buses available (see below).
- **6 Venice Marco Polo - VCE** - <http://www.veniceairport.it/> - ca. 3:30/4 hours by train from Venezia Mestre. No shuttle bus available.

From the airports above, you can either take a train or a bus.

AIRPORT SHUTTLE SERVICES

There are three main shuttle services in the area:

- **Busgroup**, <http://www.busgroup.eu/en/departure-times-airport-shuttle/>
- **Südtirol Alto Adige Bus**, <https://www.altoadigebus.com/>
- **Salzburger Mietwagen und Reise Service GmbH**, www.flughafentransfer.at – this is more expensive, and only goes to Innsbruck and Munich airports.

IMPORTANT:

The nearest well served airport with a lot of flight connections is **Verona Catullo - VRN**. We will organize Shuttle Busses during the arrival and the departure day in relation to your arrival and departure times. Therefore please indicate in the registration form **your arrival and departure time**. Without this we cannot organize the shuttle bus.

→ BY TRAIN / BUS

Please note: train or bus tickets can not be purchased on board. You have to buy them online (when available) or at the train stations.

If you are coming from the main Italian airports, you can check Italian railways timetables on <http://www.trenitalia.com/>.

We also suggest checking the website of the German railways <http://www.bahn.de/> (also good if you are coming from an Italian airport: alternatively the Austrian railways site <http://www.oebb.at/>). If you are coming from the North (i.e. Munich), definitely check the Bahn website.

In any case, you must purchase your train ticket to/from Bolzano/Bozen.

→ BY FLIXBUS:

With FlixBus you can reach the whole of Europe.

There is also a stop at the airport Milano Malpensa or Milano Bergamo (Orio al Serio aeroporto) and Bolzano. For the time schedule contact the website from: <https://www.flixbus.com/bus-routes#/map>

→ BY CAR:

Arriving from North take the **Brennero Highway A22-E45** and exit **Bolzano Nord/Bozen Nord**, arriving from South take the **Brennero Highway A22-E45** exit **Bolzano Sud/Bozen Süd**. Follow the signs direction **Zentrum/Centro**. Please note that the hotels will charge you for parking your car in their garage and that there are no “free” parking slots on the streets of Bolzano.
